This department, in conjunction with the Fire Department, has been making a survey of the accessory buildings throughout the City of San Mateo.

We find that the rabbit and chicken pens and runs and the sheds in the rear yard of the above mentioned location have become unsightly and unsafe by reason of inadequate maintenance. In our opinion, this condition constitutes a fire hazard, is dangerous to human life, and as such is a public nuisance.

We are writing you to call the above condition to your attention and to request that you take steps to abate same by repairs or demolition. Repairs or demolition should be done under a permit from this office, Building Department, Room 28, Civic Center.

A reinspection will be made by this department on Monday, December 16, 1957. We trust that this violation will be eliminated thus alleviating further action by this department.
