

This Indenture, made this, 27<sup>th</sup> day of July  
A.D. 1901, in the year of our Lord one thousand

Between Pruslin, in Volters of the County of San Mateo,  
State of California,

The Southern Pacific Railroad Corporation, a corporation  
duly organized and existing under the laws of the State  
of California,

the party of the first part, and

the party of the second part

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of

Twenty Five, (\$25.00) DOLLARS,

of the United States of America, to her in hand paid by

the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted,  
bargained and sold, pronounced, and confirmed, and by  
this presents does, grant, bargain and sell, convey  
and confirm

unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that  
certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the Western Addition of the County of  
San Mateo, State of California, and bounded and particularly  
described as follows: to-wit:-

Commencing at the Southwesterly corner of  
lot ten (10) in block twenty-three (23) of the Western Addition to the  
Town of San Mateo, distant about eight anglo thirty (80) feet northeasterly from  
the center line of the Southern Pacific Railroad, and 177 1/4 feet  
distant from the Southwesterly line of Poplar Avenue, measured along a  
line parallel to and distant thirty (30) feet at right angles Northwesterly  
from said center line of Railroad, running thence Northwesterly  
parallel to said center line and at a uniform distance of thirty  
(30) feet at right angles Northwesterly therefrom or distance  
of 50 1/2 feet to the Southwesterly corner of said lot ten (10),  
thence Northwesterly along the Northwesterly line of said  
lot ten (10) to a point that is distant forty-five (45) feet  
at right angles Northwesterly from said Railroad center  
line, thence southeasterly parallel to said center line and at a  
uniform distance of thirty-five (35) feet at right angles North-  
easterly therefrom to the Southwesterly line of said lot ten (10),  
and thence Southwesterly along said Southwesterly line of said  
lot ten (10) to the place of beginning, and containing an area of  
fifteen thousand two (15,002) acres of land, more or less.

Leaving a strip of land fifteen (15) feet in width off  
of the Southwesterly side, of said lot ten (10) in block  
twenty-three (23) of the Western Addition to the Town of  
San Mateo.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors, heirs and assigns forever.
